Adult Leaders & Chaperones

Active participation from youth and adults helps the retreat become more meaningful to all involved. We also appreciate when adult chaperones take pictures and videos which can be shared. Please make sure all youth from your congregation are fully registered two weeks before the retreat. All youth and adults need to complete an *Individual Retreat Registration Form* in order to attend. Adults attending also need to supply health forms for <u>every</u> person attending the retreat or utilize our health form. Adult Leaders & Chaperones are responsible for distributing medication, first aid treatment and supervision during the retreat.

Student Leaders

LOMO affirms the need to develop leadership skills within congregations. We invite your group to bring youth who are 16 or 17 years of age to be student leaders during your retreat. Student Leaders are people who you feel possess leadership qualities and will handle themselves in a way that younger campers will want to emulate (i.e. mature, responsible, fun, safe, etc.). Student leaders still in high school pay the regular registration fee for the retreat they are attending. We hope you will consider bringing Student Leaders with your group as a way to strengthen relationships and ministry across the generations of your congregation.

Confirmation Retreats 2018 Theme: Discipleship Redefined

Enhance your congregation's confirmation experience by stepping out of the church and into the woods. During the weekend you will explore the theme "Discipleship Redefined" with hands on Bible study activities that will engage your group. 





PRIVACY POLICY

We at Lutheran Outdoor Ministries in Ohio (LOMO) take your privacy seriously. We are committed to maintaining your trust in our services through a demonstrated respect for your personal information. The following policy governs our general information use, collection and sharing practices. Should you ever have questions or issues related to LOMO's information practices,

A. Notice

1. Who are we? LOMO is a non-profit organization incorporated in the State These images, which may be of Ohio for the three Synods in Ohio of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, ELCA. The three Synods are Northwestern Ohio, Northeastern Ohio and Southern Ohio. LOMO serves as the outdoor ministries organization for the Synods. We are a ministry sponsored by the ELCA to reach out to all people regardless of race, national origin, sex, disability or ancestry.

2. Why do we require your personally identifiable information (PII)? LOMO collects uses and shares your personally identifiable information for organizational purposes of administering camp services for campers and/ or their parents/legal guardians. We collect PII when you register to attend a camp through our website or brochures; we collect your pertinent medical information when enrolling in camps to ensure we have the necessary information to support your medical care during normal camp operations or during an emergency. We may also use images of campers taken during each camp for the purposes of education and promoting the camp(s).

3. What personally identifiable information does LOMO require, use and share? LOMO and its camp personnel require PII to run the camp's day to day operations. These operations include, but are not explicitly limited to the following activities and associated information collection:

- Camper age/date of birth
- Camper mailing and electronic mailing addresses
- Camper and parent/guardian phone numbers


If applicable, LOMO may collect individual camper medical information necessary to administer routine and emergency medical care during the camper's stay.

C. Access

To the extent possible, customers will have the timely right to review their PII to ensure such information is accurate. Should you have questions about, or updates to your PII, please contact LOMO directly per section G below. LOMO staff access to customer PII shall be limited to those with an operations-related requirement to use such information.

D. Security

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use commercially reasonable administrative, technical and physical security measures to include policies, training, computer safeguards, as well as accesscontrolled file rooms and buildings.

E. Limited Use

LOMO shall only use PII for the purposes described in this policy or in any form or document through which it collects such information.

F. Minimal Use


