Frank Dietz presented the minutes from the November meeting. They were approved on a motion from Nathan Atkins and Tom Gibson.

The treasurer's report was presented and reviewed by council members. It was approved on a motion from Gary Williams and Joe Pletcher.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Produce Market – The cold, rainy, and breezy give away was held November 21, 2023. 4995 pounds of food was distributed to 102 households. The leftover cantaloupe and cabbage went to the Salvation Army.

Finance - The Endowment Fund at the end of October was down \$4000 to \$271,000.

Worship and Music – Christmas decorations will be placed in the sanctuary December 10 after worship service. Christmas Eve service with communion will be at 7:00 P.M.

#### NEW BUSINESS 7:28 P.M.

Stovertown congregation has received our Mission Support Goal from the Southern Ohio Synod. Our recommended 2024 goal is \$6869, \$509 higher than the 2023 goal. This amount will help them reach their \$1.8 million budget. Robert Pletcher and Gary Williams motioned to make Stovertown's 2024 Mission Support Goal \$6869. After discussion, the motion passed.

Bill Thomas, Steve Wolfe, and Robert Pletcher, will be leaving church council at the end of December 2023. Linda Showers and Robert Pletcher have been elected to council positions. Council will have to appoint someone to fill the vacant position.

Frank Dietz and Nathan Atkins motioned to adjourn at 7:41 P.M. All prayed The Lord's Prayer.

The Southern Ohio Synod will hold its annual assembly Friday May 31 and Saturday June 1, 2024 at a location yet to be determined. Pastor's report was approved on a motion from Robert Pletcher and Nathan Atkins.
