VIOLENCE. IN OUR WORLD.

**"VIOLENCE... behavior involving
physical force intended to hurt, damage,
or kill someone or something."**

This past year we have read and heard of many instances of violence in our world. We have witnessed two attempted assassinations, one assassination, many protests, people set on fire, shot or stabbed, students shot in our schools and colleges,, the mass shooting of Jewish people and hate toward them. All because our world needs more compassion, understanding, tolerance, and love toward those who do not think the same way we do or have our values.

God addresses violence through the Bible with condemnation for perpetrators (God's hates violence (Proverbs 11:29) and calls for peace, non-retaliation and love. For enemies (Matthew 5:38-49, Peter 3:9) while also acknowledging God's justice against oppressors (Psalm 72:14) and noting instances where violence occurred often as a consequence of human sin or in warfare, but ultimately pointing towards a future of peace (Isaiah 2:4) Key themes include God's hatred for violent people, Jesus' call to turn the other cheek, and warnings against oppression and strife.

returns to "shine on you."

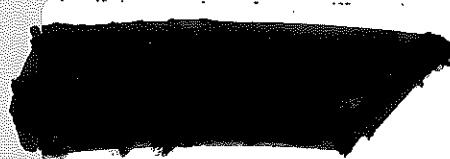
