

Pastor's report for the month of September 2023: 4 worship service and Sunday school, church council meeting, 2 hospital visits, cluster meeting in Marietta, 4 local cluster meetings, 2 days of Capital Alumni meeting at Trinity Seminary, 732 miles submitted. Pastor's report approved on a motion from Frank Dietz and Nathan Atkins.
